Extension of time and partial response to request made under the Official Information Act 1982

Thank you for your email of 21 October 2025 requesting the following information under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

- 1. We would like the full investment case document, including appendices, for each of the RoNS apart of yesterday's announcement.*
- 2. We would like all advice prepared for the Minister in the past 6 months or so from NZTA relating to the funding, financing or affordability of the programme.*

NZ Transport Agency Waka Kotahi (NZTA) is currently preparing to release all Roads of National Significance (RoNS) investment cases on its website. The shortened investment cases sent to the NZTA Board will be released in the coming weeks, followed by the release of the full investment cases (with redactions under the Act as appropriate).

I am therefore refusing part one of your request under section 18(d) as the information requested will soon be publicly available.

With regards to part 2 of your request, NZTA is extending the 20 working days available to respond to your request, as allowed for under section 15A of the Act. We require an additional 20 working days and will send you a response on or before 17 December 2025.

The deadline is being extended as the consultations necessary to make a decision on your request are such that a thorough response cannot reasonably be made within the original 20-working-day limit.

Under section 28 of the Act, you have the right to complain to the Ombudsman about my decisions on this request. More information about the Ombudsman is available online at www.ombudsman.parliament.nz.
